There, Domtar's fully integrated specialty paper mill generates 100 percent of its electricity to produce a variety of publishing, specialty and security papers, as well as many functional coating base stocks such as thermal, point of sale receipt, carbonless, labels, poly base, EDP and repositional notepad.

- The Nekoosa Mill recently upgraded its power boilers to run on natural gas instead of coal, significantly reducing its greenhouse gas emissions.
