## AT A GLANCE

Located in Northwestern Ontario, Canada, Domtar's Dryden mill produced its first unbleached pulp in 1913. More than 100 years later, the mill still produces Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft pulp. Obtained from third parties and designated wood supply allocations, the mill's softwood fiber is suitable for a variety of uses including premium paper towel and tissue, as well as specialty paper grades.
