Located in British Columbia, Canada, where the North and South Thompson rivers join, Domtar's Kamloops Mill uses softwood fiber from third-party sawmills in the region to produce high-quality Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft pulp and unbleached softwood kraft for customers from North America, China and Southeast Asia. Built in 1965, the Kamloops Mill produces pulp for a diverse range of products, such as personal hygiene products, building siding, unbreakable dishware and more.
